

## Moodle Course Overview

### Outline of a Course Page

- **Breadcrumb Trail** – each Moodle page has a horizontal breadcrumb trail at the top. The breadcrumb trail tells you where you are in the course and it allows you to return to the courses homepage at any time. *(For more details, see the section on “Getting around Moodle”)*
- **Content Block** – jump to different content areas within the current course.
- **Course Block** – there are a variety of course blocks that staff can use. Use these wisely as you don’t want to have content overload!
- **Course Content** – this is located in the middle of the screen and consists of course/unit sections. The first section usually has general information about the course. The remaining topics contain course resources, such as text documents, PowerPoint slides, web pages, images, etc and activities, such as forums, quizzes, glossaries etc.
- **Administration Block** – Course edit settings, swapping to student view and more.
